- RE: Highlights from the CoAEMSP Quarterly Board Meeting July 26-27, 2019

The Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the EMS Professions (CoAEMSP) Board of Directors met July 26-27, 2019, in Salt Lake City, Utah.

The highlights from the meeting:

- 1. **Program Actions.** Reviewed 57 programs for initial accreditation, continuing accreditation and progress reports.
- By the Numbers. At the time of the board meeting there were 631 CAAHEPⁱ accredited Paramedic programs and 65 programs that hold the CoAEMSP Letter of Review (LoR); the LoR is the precursor to CAAHEP accreditation. - 3. ACCREDITCON. The inaugural ACCREDITCON, a new conference focused only on the accreditation standards, debuted May 31-June 2, 2019, supporting the CoAEMSP's mission "to advance the quality of EMS education through accreditation" and responding to the needs of nearly 700 Paramedic educational programs. [Annually there are about 160 program directors that change. As of July 25, there were 110 program director changes in calendar year 2019.] ACCREDITCON drew nearly 500 people. - 4. **Outreach.** The CoAEMSP, represented by its Executive Director, is participating in the NHTSA discussion surrounding nomenclature as well as rewriting the EMS Education Standards.

Senior staff have met with various states to temper concerns about accreditation, demystifying the misconceptions.

- 5. Accreditation of AEMT Programs. CoAEMSP has a group working on accreditation for AEMT programs as we have received several requests from State Offices of EMS and Programs to offer accreditation at the AEMT level.
- 6. Audit Committee presented the 2017-18 audit results, which included the auditor providing the CoAEMSP a clean bill of health.
- 7. Data (Research) Committee has several research projects in progress, including:
 - High Performing Paramedic Programs (current)
 - Paramedic Education Competencies (current)
 - The current status of students with disabilities in EMS (assisting with)
 - The turnover of Paramedic Education Program Directors (assisting with)
 - Active Learning and the Flipped Classroom (assisting with)
 - Socially Equitable Access to EMS (assisting with)
 - Safety Risks Encountered by Paramedic Students (assisting with)



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- 8. **Finance Committee** is developing policies to strengthen the organization's policies on reserves.
- 9. **Governance Committee** presented and gained approval for policies specific to the Board, including codifying the spokesperson for the CoAEMSP, annual review of the strategic plan, and regular review of the crisis management plan.
- 10. Quality Improvement presented the results of the 2019 annual report, which included:
 - a. Submitted reports: 675 reports
 - b. Retention: 172 below threshold (threshold is 70%)
 - c. Written Exam: 91 below threshold (threshold is 70%)
 - d. Positive Placement: 24 below threshold (threshold is 70%)
- 11. Site Visit & Visitor Committee is offering a Site Visitor Workshop in 2020, increasing its cadre of 100+ site visitors. Site visitors are Paramedic educators, primarily program directors and medical directors from programs in good standing and have demonstrated an understanding of the CAAHEP *Standards* and the CoAEMSP policies.
- 12. **Directors' Elections** occur every summer, approximately one-third of the board members are up for election. Those elected this year:
