II.C Minimum Expectations

"To prepare competent entry-level Paramedics in the cognitive (knowledge), psychomotor (skills), and affective (behavior) learning domains with or without exit points at the Advanced Emergency Medical Technician and/or Emergency Medical Technician, and/or Emergency Medical Responder levels."



Standard IV. A.1 and IV.A.2 Student Evaluation

Achievement of the program competencies required for graduation must be assessed by criterion referenced, summative, comprehensive final evaluations in all learning domains.

Records of student evaluations must be maintained in sufficient detail to document learning progress and achievements



Standards Interpretations

- The program must teach, monitor, and evaluate (i.e. grade) the attitudes and behaviors of the students, including interpersonal interactions.
- At least one comprehensive affective evaluation of each student
- Evidence of counseling, remediation, and reevaluation
- Terminal competency
