Why do we do an Annual Report?

Three functions of the Annual Report

Transparency with the public
 Opportunity for self-analysis and action planning
 CHEA/CAAHEP requirement

The Annual Report is a snapshot in time

What are those pesky outcomes thresholds?



Retention: includes attrition for all reasons



Positive Placement





First 3 attempts

All thresholds are 70%

- Programs are required to survey all *placed* graduates and employers
 - Programs analyze responses, create an action plan
 - Important metric!!

National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians® THE NATION'S EMS CERTIFICATION

Number passing: first attempt

First time a graduate takes and passes the exam

Number passing: third attempt cumulative pass rate

First, second, and third time a graduate takes and passes the exam

This does not include any subsequent attempts and passes after the third attempt

Process

What is the process for the AR?

Tool is Excel-based

AR is completed for *each year* and there is *no* cumulative average

Tracking of the 3 consecutive year results process began with 2018 reporting year (theoretically)



Credible education through accreditation

Why use a calendar year? Can't we use our academic year?

Calendar year is a common reporting period

Report includes all graduates in the year

2020





Can I change the report after it is submitted?

- Cannot 'go back' and add graduates in the previous year's report
- Cannot amend or edit a report once submitted
- Graduates not completing 'on-time' will count as attrition if not completed in the reporting calendar year
- However, the program can add late graduates as a 'cohort' in the following reporting year

What? A new way to figure attrition?

Institutions may establish policies for add/drop

However

For CoAEMSP reporting students will be counted as attrition if they withdraw or are dropped after 10% of the *entire* Paramedic curriculum

We have multiple courses: how does that affect the 10% calculation?

- Calculate the number of contact hours for the Paramedic content over the entirety of the program
- Include only Paramedic curricula
- **Do not include prerequisites or co requisites**
- Do not include general education courses
- Average programs continues to average 1100-1200 hours
- □ 10% = 110 120 hours Get Out of Jail Free hours



Credible education through accreditation

Not all our graduates take the certifying exam: does that count against us?



- Enter the number of graduates attempting the exam
- Calculation for exam pass rate is based on the number attempted, not number of graduates
- Methodology allows both state and NREMT but total must not exceed the number of graduates

I don't have any returns for Graduate and Employer surveys

AR includes:


- Number of surveys sent to and received from *placed* graduates
- Same for employers of graduates
- Program's analysis of the survey information received
- Action plan of the program to incorporate the data to improve their program
- 220

Based on the number of graduates employed or continuing education or serving in the military or volunteering

What is the purpose of Graduate Surveys?



Evaluate knowledge, skills, and abilities of the graduate as a *Paramedic* from the graduate's perspective

Hence: a minimum of six months of experience

Evaluates all three domains

Purpose of the survey is *not* to determine where the graduate is employed: info should be on file



Credible education through accreditation

What is the purpose of Employer Surveys?

EMPLOYER JESTIONNAIF Evaluate knowledge, skills, and abilities of the graduate as a *Paramedic* from the employer's perspective

Hence: a minimum of six months of experience as a paramedic

Evaluates all three domains





How do I get the Annual Report?

- Annual Report for 2020 is now available
- Sent via email only to the Program Director
- Annual Report is not posted on the CoAEMSP website
- Annual Report is due no later than May 15th each year
- No extensions will be granted
- **Submission year is 2022**
- **Reporting year is 2020**
- The 'delay' allows Programs to account for late graduates in the reporting year

Annual Reports are included in the Site Visitor information provided with the self-study report and programs will be required to provide the evidence onsite to support the data reported in their Annual Reports



How do I complete this report?

- AR tool automatically calculates and color codes percentages
- Thresholds that fail to meet 70% appear in red
 - Fields appear for analysis and action plan
 - Standardized questions appear
- Fields with errors are flagged with yellow

Completing the Annual Report



On-time graduation defined

Students must be identified in cohorts

What is a cohort? Group of students who begin the class at the same time


Required maximum amount of time to complete a program is a common academic requirement Reasonable amount of time that students should be able to complete all program components: didactic, lab, clinical, field


What does publishing outcomes mean?

- Results must be published on the Program website home page
 - Post outcomes from the most recent Annual Report
 - May post prior years if desired
- Published results must be consistent with and verifiable by the latest AR

The published website must be listed in the AR

What happens if we don't meet the thresholds?

- Potential actions do not occur until a program has continued to fall below a threshold for three consecutive years
- If a threshold is not met for the third consecutive year, the Program may be forwarded to the Board for a recommendation of probation

First actionable year: stay tuned!





What! Probation??

- Once on Probationary Accreditation, the Program will have up to 2 years to demonstrate compliance
- If not in compliance, accreditation may be Involuntarily Withdrawn or program may Voluntarily Withdraw

Can my program get in trouble?

CoAEMSP Letter of Review Programs

- □ Failure to submit the AR → LoR Suspended
- \$500 late processing fee assessed
- □ Failure to address suspension
 → LoR revoked

Prevents program from re-entering the accreditation process for 3 years CAAHEP Accredited Programs

- □ Failure to submit the AR
 → Administrative Probation
- \$500 late processing fee assessed
- Failure to address
 Administrative Probation
 → may lead to Withdrawal of Accreditation





Is there an exception for small programs?

big small

- Short answer: not really
- When thresholds are not met, detail specific factors in the analysis and action plan fields





What causes errors?

- On-time graduation dates that differ from the calendar year being reported
- Reporting numbers resulting in the outcome percentage that are above 100%
- Blank or unanswered cells

Error has occurred; The pass rate success percentage cannot be more than 100%

Learn from the past.....

Programs must have access to student data and records if the campus is closed



Don't procrastinate!

Remember you are reporting on graduates from at least 12 months ago

Review answers to research questions carefully. 2019 report included:

- 85 full time faculty
- 4800 total instructional hours
- 1920 capstone hours

Fun Facts 2019 Annual Report

690 reports submitted for 2019 reporting year

50 programs reported no graduates in 2019 Total number of students enrolled: 17,457

Total number of graduates: 13,884

Retention rate of 80%

52% of programs enrolled less than 20 students

63% of programs graduated less than 20 students Only 13 programs graduated more than 100 students (2%)




