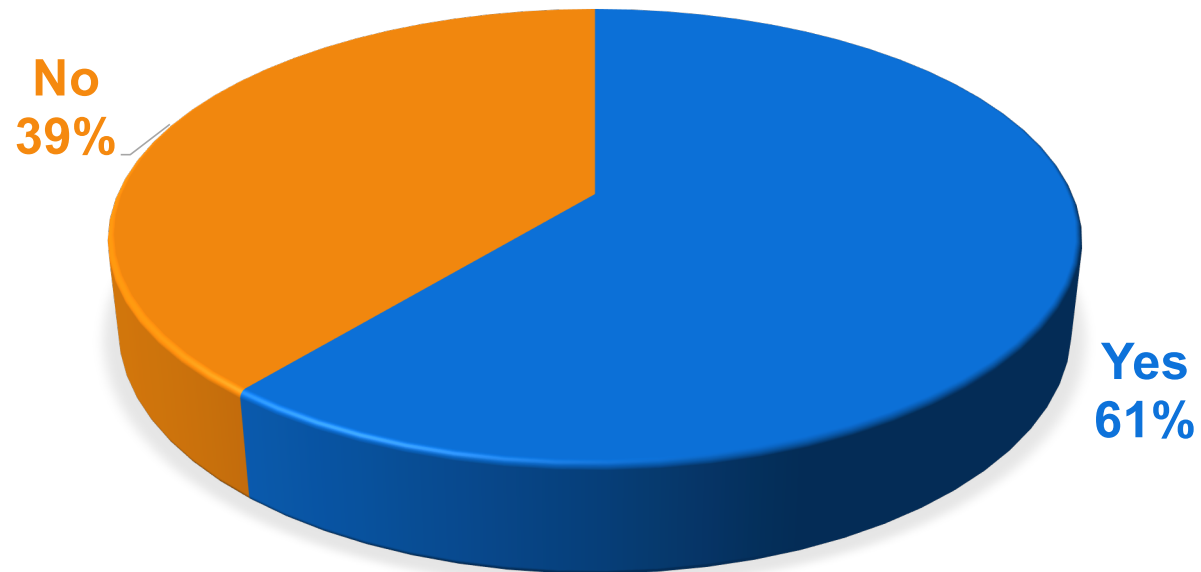

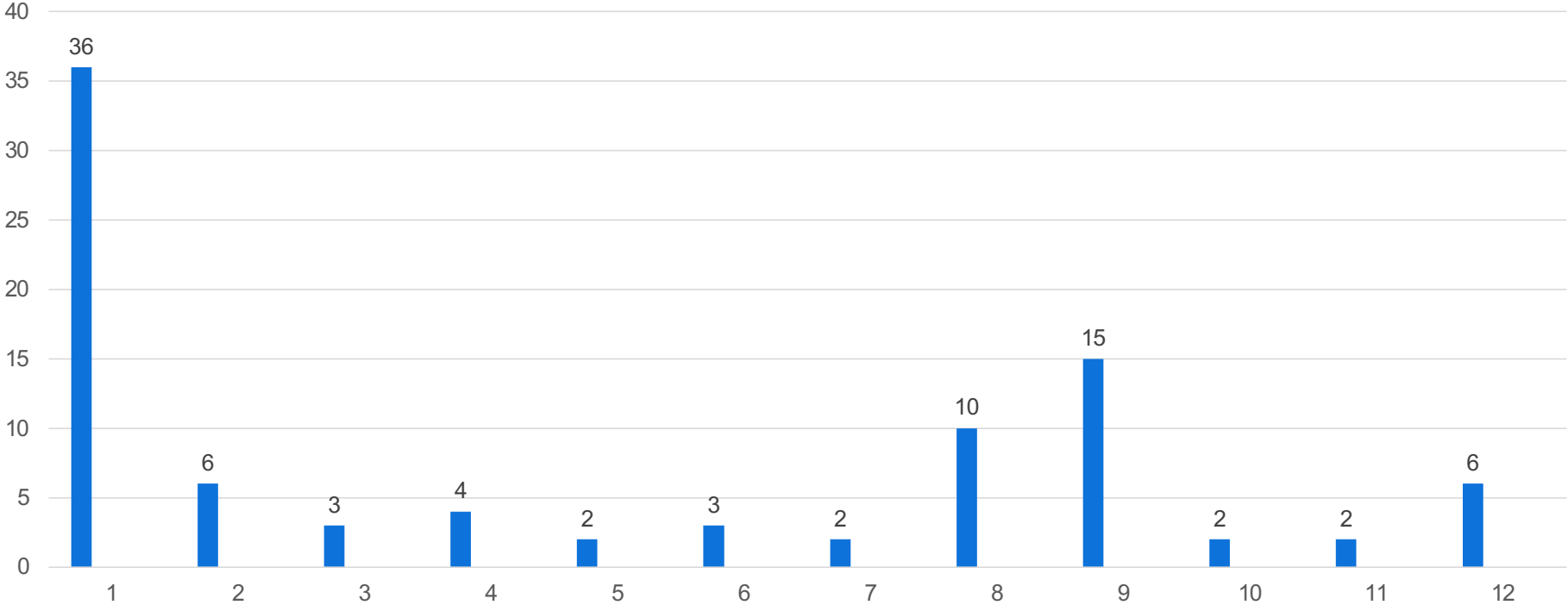


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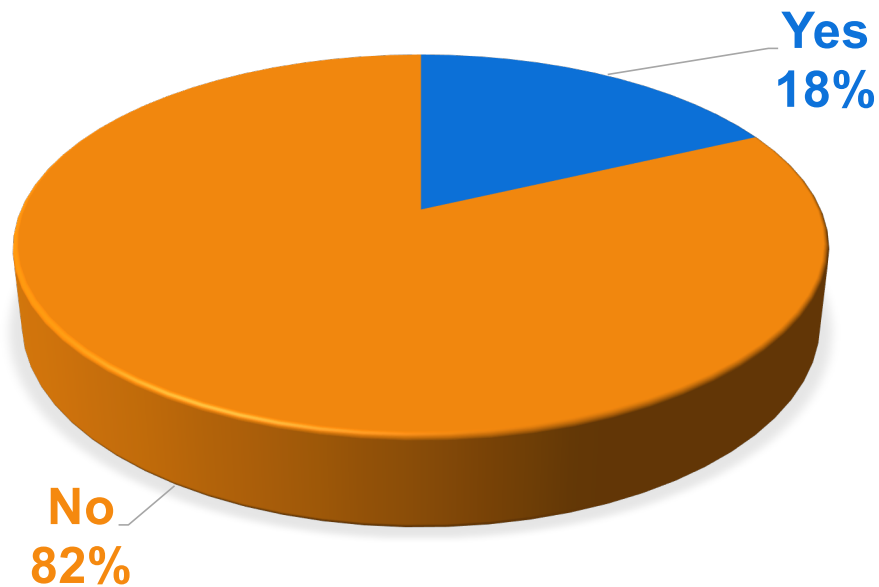
# Have you implemented the 2023 SMC?



# How many months ago did you implement the 2023 SMC?

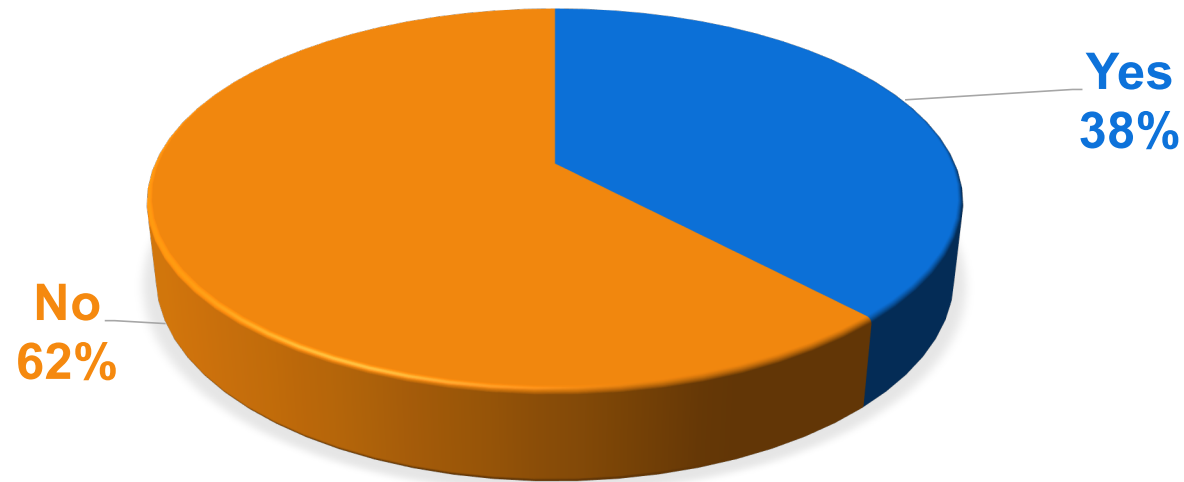


# Have students graduated from your program having met the recommendations outlined in the 2023 SMC?





# Did your program make any changes to the minimum recommendations in the 2023 SMC?



## What changes were made? Increases...

- Overall, increased numbers for skills, pathologies, and contacts
- Added pediatric intubation category
- Added OG tubes, CPAP, nasotracheal intubation
- Increased cardiac arrest, electrical therapy, ventilations, intubations (live), and IVs
- Increased pediatric, geriatric and trauma contacts
- Added observing childbirth and participating in cardiac arrests
- Increased Capstone Team Leads (30, 40, 50)



## What changes were made? Decreases...

- Lowered number of team leads to 15 (rural program)
- Challenging to meet number of pediatric contacts (rural)
